

## Summary of proposed changes to the draft statement of licensing policy under the Gambling Act 2005

<b>Chapter one (pages 5 to 10) Introduction</b>	<b>Chapter containing the introduction to the Policy</b>
<b>Sub-section</b>	<b>Changes</b>
Paragraph 1.14 d)	Amend paragraph to include “our Local Area Profile”
Paragraph 1.15	Amend paragraph to include the sentence “However, we retain the discretion not to grant a premises licence if we think that the application does not accord with the matters list in paragraph 1.14 above.”
<b>Chapter five (pages 21 to 29) Premises licences</b>	<b>Chapter identifies the different types of premises licence and sets out Camden’s expectations of gambling operators.</b>
<b>Sub-section</b>	<b>Changes</b>
Paragraphs 5.15, 5.21, 5.22 and 5.25	Amend the paragraphs relating to the machine entitlement for each premises type.
<b>Chapter six (pages 30 to 35) Permits and notices</b>	<b>Chapter identifies the different types of permits, notices and registrations; and sets out Camden’s expectations of gambling operators.</b>

Paragraph 6.22	Amend the paragraphs relating to the machine entitlement at clubs.
