NEIGHBOURHOODS OF THE FUTURE HEALTHY SCHOOLS STREETS SCHEME (SC/2019/55)

Consideration was given to a report of the Director of Regeneration and Planning.

DECISION –

THAT, having considered the equalities impact assessment at Appendix 1 of the report, and having had due regard to the needs set out in section 149 of the Equality Act 2010, the following measures be approved under an Experimental Traffic Order (ETO), subject to compliance with relevant statutory requirements:

- (i) To create a Healthy School Street (HSS) Zone incorporating Netherhall Gardens, Maresfield Gardens, Nutley Terrace and the southern part of Frognaal, as detailed in paragraph 2.2 of the report;
- (ii) To undertake a 12 month period of monitoring during the ETO, and use the data gathered to consult on making the scheme permanent at the end of the trial; and
- (iii) To delegate authority to the Director of Regeneration and Planning to make any minor changes to the scheme that may be required during the ETO period.
