<b>Youth Engagement Team Activities</b>	Bicycle Maintenance Project, Metro Box, ASSIST (Arsenal Hub), Local Village Network, Employability Project, Care Homes Outreach.	Activities will be planned throughout the Summer 2022.
<b>ASB Intervention Scheme</b> <b>ASB</b>	Working with partners to deliver high performance on the ASB Intervention Scheme and continue to refer and tackle ASB related crime.	Summer 2022
<b>Junior Citizen Scheme</b>	Designed to engage with directly with young people to provide safety advice as part of the ongoing MPS trust and confidence plan.	June/July 2022
<b>Operation Pantera</b>	Intelligence led activity designed to prevent/tackle 'Cuckooing', which sees the exploitation of vulnerable residents by drug dealers who seek to use their properties.	Ongoing
<b>Test Purchasing &amp; Trading Standards</b>	Targeted operations delivered in partnership with Camden Council Trading Standards to tackle the illegal sale of alcohol, tobacco and knives.	Ongoing
<b>Operation Sitar</b>	Targeted operation specifically directed to tackle bike-enabled robberies in specific hot spot locations	Summer 2022.
<b>Walk &amp; Talk</b>	This is part of the MPS commitment to tackle VAWG. Engagement with local women to obtain more information about their lived experiences. Activity designed to build trust and confidence in the Police.	Summer 2022
<b>Operation Deck</b>	Targeted operational activity designed to tackle ASB and serious youth violence.	Summer 2022

<b>DIVERT</b>	DIVERT Application which will allow officers within Neighbourhood Policing to make early engagement with our youth communities, specifically those who have had contact with the police, or show vulnerability to committing offences linked with serious youth violence. The aim is to have all Neighbourhood Policing Officers trained by the summer, and to empower them to have the knowledge and confidence to begin making referrals.	April to September 2022
<b>Positive Action Initiatives</b>	Neighbourhood Policing Teams tackling relevant issues within their wards. Activity to align with the Police Summer Violence plan – with an increase in weapons sweeps and other relevant activity.	Summer 2022
<b>Ask For Angela</b>	Continued engagement with Camden Licensed Premises – activity to continue as part of the Camden Women’s Safety (Public Realm) Action Plan.	Ongoing
<b>Operation Push</b>	Targeted Camden focussed operation to reduce robbery and snatches in the vicinity of Camden Town Centre.	Summer 2022.
<b>Operation Encompass</b>	Review of domestic violence reports with plans agreed in partnership with the relevant Camden safeguarding services and partner agencies.	Summer 2022
<b>Operation Verona</b>	Focus on responding to StreetSafe reports and intelligence with regard to women’s safety.	Summer 2022
<b>Operation Arawn</b>	Hate Crime weeks of action focussing on victim support, reporting and work with key partners to build trust and confidence.	w/c: 13th June, 11th July, 8th August, 12 <sup>th</sup> September 2022
<b>Operation Cichild</b>	Operation to tackle the ongoing problems of violence, drug and gang activity in the Kilburn area.	Summer 2022
<b>Operation Nightingale</b>	Met Police wide initiative designed tackle robbery related offending.	Summer 2022
<b>Operation Greenspool</b>	Specifically tackling robbery in the Bloomsbury/Tottenham Court Road area	Summer 2022
